GENERAL COMMITTEE'S MESSAGE

Dear Members,

We are happy to announce that the General Committee (GC) at its meeting held on 26th May 2010 has decided that the Annual General Meeting (AGM) will be held on Sunday, 27th June 2010 at 10.00am. You will receive the official Notice of the AGM in the next few days and followed by the Annual Report containing the GC's financial Statements for the year ended 31st December 2009 and the Auditor's Report thereon.

Since this is an election year for a new team of GC Members for the year 2010/2012, we urge as many Members as possible to step forward and offer themselves as candidates so that the Members will have a wide choice of candidates, and hopefully the most hardworking and the most capable will be chosen. We believe there are many talented Members including professionals, business executives, civil servants, captains of industries etc. I also sincerely believe that the best thing one can do for society is to do volunteer services without any thought of reward either in cash or in kind, however maybe alright to ask for divine blessing.

Two months ago, the GC have through the Samanea, Circulars and Notices to Members explained why we were unable to have the AGM before 31st March 2010 as stated in the Court Order dated 08/01/2010 - the reason being that to do so would have been unconstitutional and in violation of the Constitutional Rules Clause 43 which state that at the AGM of the Club, the Audited Accounts for the preceding financial year must be presented to the Members. To further illustrate the issues, the GC had stated the time frame and stages which the Auditors would take to produce the final Audited Financial Statements and Report thereon.

The GC had also painstakingly explained to the Members why it was necessary to suspend the duties of the President, Michael Chiam Tow Hui and the Hon. Secretary, Chow Seck Kai. As stated in the February 2010 issue of the Samanea, the majority of the Members of the GC passed a vote of no confidence against the President and the Hon. Secretary for failing in their fiduciary duties to act in the best interest of the Club and its Members and also for undermining the GC. The powers of GC are stated in Rules Nos. 52 and 53 of the Club's Constitution.

Unfortunately, a handful of Members have stubbornly refused to accept the GC's explanation and have through emails and text messages as well as verbally been spreading lies, half-truths and distorting facts about the GC. Their words and actions have caused discord, disharmony, unnecessary friction and division amongst the Members.

This small group had even gone round the Club with yet another petition for EGM with the preamble stating that the GC had "changed and/or altered the Constitutional Rules".

The petition even stated that the GC had "total disregard and showed disrespect to the laws of the country and abused of the Club's Constitution". This allegation is utter rubbish and made to deceive Members.

In view of the activities of this small group, many Members have urged the GC to take disciplinary action to suspend or expel them. However, we have resisted taking action against them in the greater interest of the Club. We believe that any further action will only deepen the division and add more disharmonies.

On a happier note, the Club hosted two major events in the month of May 2010. One was Mother's Day, which was celebrated on 9 May 2010. It was a grand affair, attended by about 200 Members, invited Guests and children. The other was the prestigious Annual Raintree Invitational Inter-Club Tennis Tournament 2010. A total of 10 Clubs, including teams from Thailand and Singapore took part. Once again, we are proud that team Raintree Tigers emerged the champion. Congratulations to Raintree Tigers.

Lastly, we hope all of you will make a special effort to attend the coming AGM and vote in a new team of GC Members.

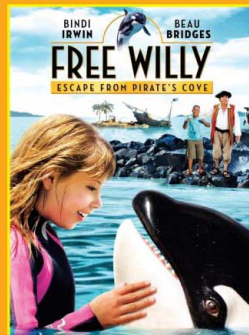
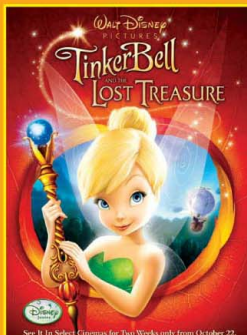
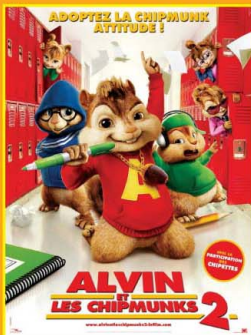
CHILDREN'S ACTIVITY

REASONS FOR CLOSURE OF THE BOWLING ALLEY

The problems of the Bowling Alley started with the building of the gymnasium on the top of the bowling alley building. The contractor for the gymnasium agreed to cover the 8 bowling lanes with water-proof sheets to ensure that while construction work was in progress on the roof top, no water will flow onto the bowling lanes and the bowling machines. Unfortunately, the bowling lanes and machines were badly damaged by water from the top.

On 1st March 2004, Action Masters Sdn Bhd (AM) was hired by the Club to refurbish the bowling alley. AM dismantled and removed all the existing lanes and the bowling machine from 1st March 2004 till 21st March 2004. AM recommended that the Club buy a second-hand bowling machine from China. Two Committee Members, a Bowling Coach and a Maintenance Executive went to Guangzhou, China to inspect the bowling equipment. The bowling equipment was shipped from Guangzhou, China on 16th April 2004 and delivered to the Club on 27th April 2004. The total contract value including testing and commissioning was RM470, 700.00

A little after May 2005, after the warranty period had expired, defects started to surface. The Club sent letters to AM stating the defects but AM failed to respond. In 2008, a task force was formed for repair work to be conducted throughout the bowling alley. Bowling Coach, Mr. Ricky Yong recommended Strike in Bowling Equipment Supplies as the Contractor for the project.

The Bowling Task Force Committee awarded this project to Strike in Bowling Equipment Suppliers at the cost of RM3995.00 and elected Mr. Teo Kah Chi as Consultant. However in May 2008, only 2 bowling lanes were working. After servicing by Strike in June 2008, only 5 bowling lanes were usable.

While repairing the 8 lanes, Mr Teo's technician discovered that the following parts needed to be changed:-

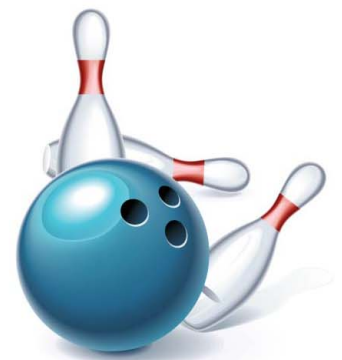
Since the machine is a second-hand machine, many parts were not available in Malaysia. Therefore, parts were replaced from other lanes. This process of replacing parts from other lanes continued until there were no more parts from other lanes which resulted in the total closure of the bowling alley.

The obvious question is why buy a second-hand bowling machine when at the 18th AGM 2003, the House approved a sum of RM600, 00.00 for the refurbishment for the bowling alley.

The budget for the upgrading and repair of the Bowling Lanes was not approved during the 2009 AGM Capital Expenditure Budget. Hence, the General Committee can't proceed with the repair and upgrading works.

This question can only be answered by the President and/or GC for the year 2003/2004.
