EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING

12 JUNE 2022 | 10.00 AM

SUMMARY OF EXTRAORDINARY GENERAL MEETING ("EGM") HELD ON 12 JUNE 2022

The EGM was held on Sunday, 12 June 2022 at 10:00 a.m. for the following purposes:-

1. To receive the Report of the Task Force on the Solar Panel Project.
2. For members to approve the installation of a Solar Panel System known as Solar Photovoltaic System at the roof of the Sports Pavilion with a total cost not exceeding the sum of RM1,300,000.
3. IF the Solar Panel Project is approved, members to decide/approve the installation either by outright purchase financed by a banking facility or financed vide a Power Purchase Agreement ("PPA").

A total of 78 members attended the EGM.

The Report of the Task Force on the Solar Panel Project was duly received by the members.

After a session of Q&A with the Task Force, the following **amended resolution** (in bold) was put to vote:

"That the installation of a Solar Panel System known as Solar Photovoltaic System at the roof of the Sports Pavilion with a total cost not exceeding the sum of Ringgit Malaysia One Million Three Hundred Thousand (RM1,300,000) be and is hereby approved, with the precise terms and conditions to be determined by the General Committee. "	Results: 52 members voted in favour, 4 against with 5 abstained.
"That the installation of a Solar Photovoltaic System by outright purchase to be financed with a banking facility (the terms and conditions thereof to be determined by the General Committee) be and is hereby approved."	Results: 44 members voted in favour, Nil against with 1 abstained.

In summary, the members have voted for the installation of a Solar Panel System known as Solar Photovoltaic System at the roof of the Sports Pavilion with a total cost not exceeding RM1,300,000 by outright purchase with the precise terms and conditions to be determined by the General Committee.

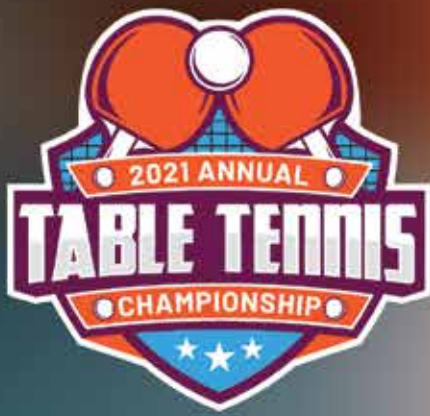

Doubles Open

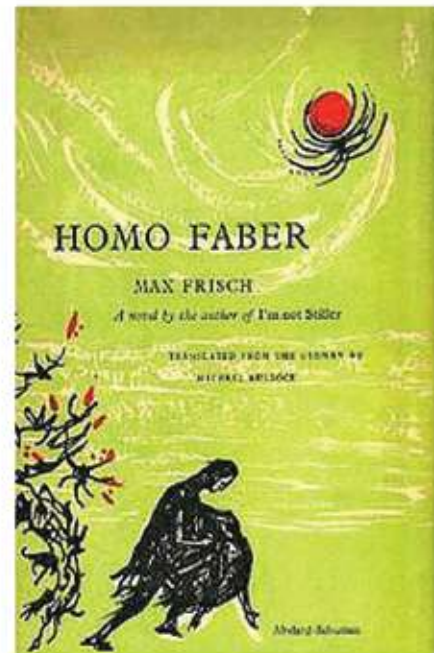
Champion: Madam Chris Goh & Mr Cheng Chee Choong

BOOK APPRECIATION GROUP



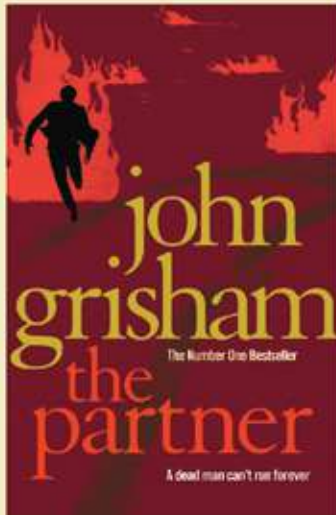
NOVEMBER READ

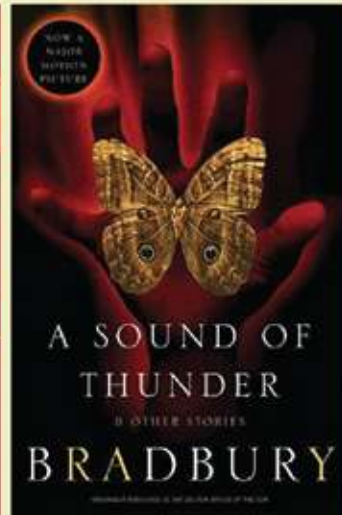

Whilst I was still reading regularly, it was mostly news reports or technical articles relating to my work. From time to time I still read a fiction book from a few favorite authors.

All this has changed since joining the BAG. I was 'forced' to read books from authors and topics I would not have done on my own. And I have enjoyed all these new 'experiences'. I got to know the challenges of life in Afghanistan under the Taliban (*A thousand splendid suns* by Khaled Hosseini), spent some time in the Egyptian desert in World War II (*The English Patient* by Michael Ondaatje) or experienced the Japanese occupation in Malaysia during the same period (*The gift of rain* by Tan Twan Eng).

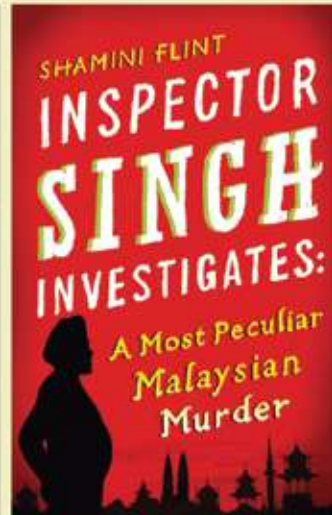

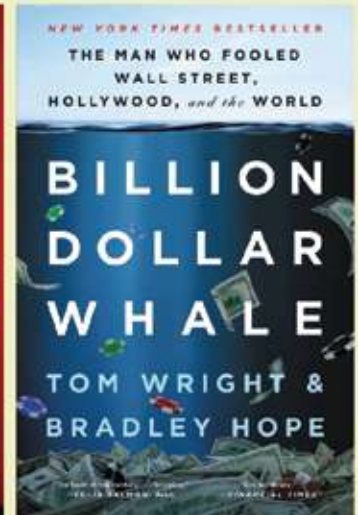
