THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTIONS WERE APPROVED AT THE 38TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING (AGM) WHICH TOOK PLACE ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2023.

RESOLUTION 1: Proposed Installation of a Solar Panel System

Whereas, after having reviewed the proposal by the Solar Panel Task Force and monitored the power consumption of the Club for the period from 24th November 2022 to 5th December 2022, the General Committee hereby proposes that the Club install a 195kw Solar Panel System at a total cost not exceeding Ringgit Six Hundred Thousand (RM600,000.00) to meet the Club's daytime electric consumption demand.

Therefore, be it resolved that the proposed installation of a Solar Panel System be hereby approved and the funds required for its installation be raised through a Solar Project Fee to be charged to the Members as a monthly contribution of **Ringgit Thirty (RM30) for ten (10) months beginning in October 2023**. This contribution will, pursuant to Rule 22 (i), be in addition to the monthly club subscription currently payable by Members.

RESOLUTION 2: Proposed upgrading repair work for Outdoor Tennis Courts

Read together with Resolution 5:

"That approval be given to carry out the upgrading repair work of two (2) Outdoor Tennis Court at a cost not exceeding Ringgit One hundred and Fifty Thousand (RM150, 000.00)".

RESOLUTION 3: Proposed amendments to Rule 37A

To substitute the words "ten (10)" with "three (3)"; insert a comma "," after the word "children" followed by the words "siblings, nephews, nieces, or other family members; and insert after the bracketed words "(the Transferee)" the words "subject to the prior approval of the General Committee."

Remarks: The above resolution will be implemented prior to approval from the Registrar of Society (ROS).

RESOLUTION 4: The proposed repair to the metal deck roof at the Sports Pavilion

"That approval be given out to carry out the upgrading repair work of the metal deck roof at a cost not exceeding Ringgit Two Hundred Thousand (RM200, 000.00) and the funds required for this work shall be raised through a Metal Roof Repair Fee to be charged to the Members as a monthly contribution **of Ringgit Thirty (Rm30) for three (3) months beginning in August 2024**. This contribution will, pursuant to Rule 22 (i), be in addition to the monthly club subscription currently payable by Members".

RESOLUTION 5: Proposed resolution to modify resolution 2

To substitute the words "two (2)" with "three (3)", and the words "One Hundred and Fifty Thousand (RM150, 000.00)" with "Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand (RM250, 000.00)" for RESOLUTION 2 which shall thereafter read as follows:

"That approval is given to carry out the upgrading and repair work for **three (3) Outdoor Tennis Courts** at a cost not exceeding Ringgit **Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand (RM250,000.00)**".

RESOLUTION 6: Repair and Refurbishing of the Existing Bowling Alley (8 Lanes) and Machinery

"That approval be given to carry out the repair and refurbishment work of the Existing Bowling Alley at a cost not exceeding Ringgit Three Hundred Fifty One Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Eight (RM351,528.00) and the funds required for this work shall be considered and determined by the General Committee".

TENNIS ARTICLES

2023 has seen a resurgence of Tennis activity at the Club. Social Nights, Ladies Social Morning and Junior coaching have continued to be popular throughout the year. Club Friendlies, Next Gen events, Carnivals and Social Sundays have also kept the calendar busy.

However, two events have been a constant feature throughout the year. One is the Interclub Premier League and the other is the Raintree Open Singles Tennis League (ROSTL).

The Interclub Premier League was expanded in 2023 to eight (8) clubs from the KL and Klang Valley area. The season began in February and, after playing a total of 14 matches, concluded in September. Raintree played each Club home and away and a match required five (5) doubles pairs (men's, ladies and mixed) to make up the team. Over the course of the season, Raintree was represented by 32 different players, which shows the strength-in-depth of our Tennis community.

At the conclusion of the season, Raintree were crowned CHAMPIONS, having topped the table by three points from Royal Lake Club in second place. This title means Raintree has now been victorious in all three editions of the Premier League – 2018, 2019 and now 2023. We will now turn our attention to the 2024 season and the challenge of defending our title.

In February ROSTL was launched with a new format designed to encourage greater participation and provide more opportunity to play competitive singles. The new format has been extremely successful. The league concluded at the end of September after 356 singles matches, involving 45 players. The top 24 players in the league progressed to the playoffs in October, with the winners being determined on Finals weekend at the start of November.

The success of the 2023 ROSTL edition means a 2024 edition will be launched with the hope of attracting even greater participation.

BOOK APPRECIATION GROUP



Book Appreciation Group (BAG) – A book is a gift that you can open over and over again.

Recently I bought some books in a book shop and on the bag the sentence 'A book is a gift that you can open over and over again' was imprinted. It reminded me about the pleasures reading books can bring, and how immersing reading a good book can be. At the BAG we continued to plunge ourselves into some amazing books in the past few months.

In May we read '**Every Version of You**' by **Grace Chan** a dystopian sci-fi story about how life could look like at the end of the century in a hyper-consumerist society. Interesting to know that the book was written by the relative of Raintree member.

18th-century France was the setting of our book in June which follows the life of Jean-Baptiste Grenouille who is born with an exceptional sense of smell. He becomes a perfumer who is involved in a murder when Jean-Baptiste encounters a young girl with an unsurpassed wondrous scent. **Perfume: The Story of a Murderer** by **Patrick Sueskind** is one of the best-selling German novels in the 20th century.

In July we read for the first time a book by an Indian author, **Kiran Desai**, called **The Inheritance of Loss** which won several awards including the Booker Prize of 2006 and centers around the lives of Biju and Sai two young Indians living in the United States and India. The major theme of the book is related to colonialism and post-colonialism.

Incidentally, our next book '**The Bonfire of the Vanities**' by **Tom Wolfe** plays around the same time as 'Inheritance of Loss' (i.e., 1980s) and tells the story of a successful New York City bond trader, and how taking a wrong turn on a highway destroys his whole life. The book became a major bestseller and received strong reviews for its accurate and devastating portrayal of the New York Society.

World War II was the setting of our latest book '**All the Light we cannot see**' by **Anthony Doerr** which revolves around the characters Marie-Laure LeBlanc, a blind French girl and Werner Pfennig, a bright German boy. The novel won the Pulitzer Price for Fiction in 2014.

So why not joining BAG to be part of such book experiences? We tend to meet on the first Sunday of the month at Raintree at 2:30pm and discuss about the book of the month and topics relating to it for about 2 hours. Please feel free to join even if you did not have the opportunity to read the book as after a short introduction to it, we tend to discuss about topics which it is not necessary to have read the book.

On Sunday, 3 December, at 2:30pm, we discuss '**The Stationery Shop of Tehran**' novel by **Marjan Kamali** that unfolds against the backdrop of political upheaval in 1953 Iran. The story revolves around the love between Roya and Bahman, two young individuals who meet in a stationery shop. However, their romance is disrupted by a coup that alters the course of their lives.

For 2024, book selected is '**The Sense of an Ending**' by **Julian Barnes**. which we are planning to discuss about in January.

As part of our ongoing commitment to safety and well-being, The Raintree Club staff has recently completed an AED (Automated External Defibrillator) course. This essential training equips our team with the skills to respond effectively in case of a medical emergency within our club's premises.

Raintree is dedicated to providing a secure and welcoming environment for all our members. We believe that a proactive approach to safety is essential, and our staff's successful completion of the AED course aligns perfectly with this commitment.

Notably, we have strategically placed two AED machines within our club, ensuring that we are well-prepared for any medical emergency. These life-saving devices can be found at the following locations:

- Sports Area: Sport Counter
- Reception Area: Reception Counter

The AED course covered a range of crucial topics, including:

- Identifying Cardiac Emergencies
- Proper AED Usage
- Conducting CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation)
- First Aid
