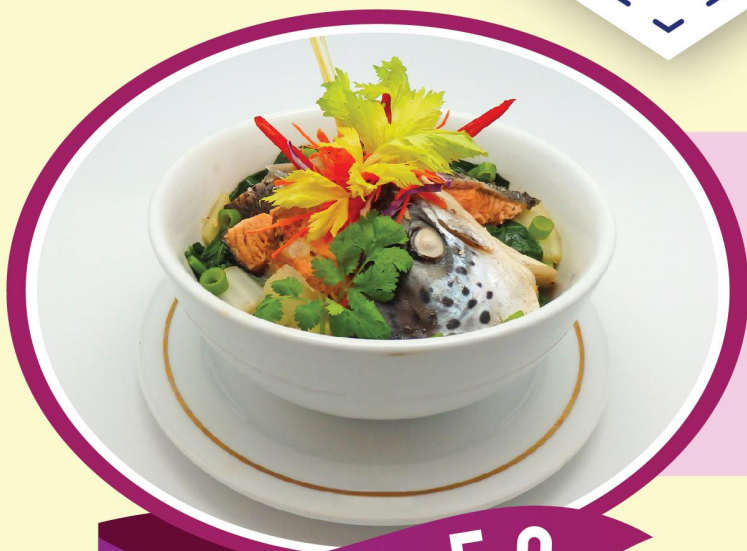

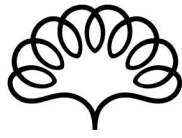

# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

*D*ear Members,

It was not too long ago that I wrote about how the landscape surrounding the Club has changed over the years, from quiet countryside with lush greenery to a bustling city suburb. I also mentioned the prospect of a highway running right in front of the Club – one of the main reasons for the re-location of the main entrance of the Club to Jalan Wickham. In fact, we have since had confirmation that a new RM 3.8 billion highway, known as the DUKE Phase 3 or DUKE 3, is to be built. This 30km highway, which when completed will link Wangsa Maju, Setiawangsa, Ampang, the Tun Razak Exchange, the Malaysian Urban Development Corridor and Kerinchi, will be elevated on the stretch of road in front of the Club. Members will, I am afraid, have to brace themselves for more disruption once construction activities get under way. However, we hope that the easier access and better connectivity this new phase of the DUKE highway will offer once completed, will improve the amenity and value of the Club in the longer term.

The past year has at least been positive for the Club's membership, despite the overall gloomy economic outlook. The total number of terminated memberships held by the Club has now dropped to an all-time low of 86 from a peak of 228 in 2012. Our belief that lowering our selling price would generate more sales and so boost membership (and with it income for the Club) has paid off, despite the doubters. We are particularly pleased that many Members have taken advantage of the 2nd Generation Scheme to buy memberships for their children. With the number of unsold memberships now much reduced and falling further, the price of individual membership has now been put back up to RM 10,000. We believe that this is a fair – indeed, still very favourable – price for membership given the location of the Club, and its facilities and amenities.

On 24th January 2016, a Family Day was organized to mark the re-opening of the Club swimming pool after a period of three months of closure, during which the pool surroundings, the filtration equipment and the pool itself were replaced or upgraded substantially. The event was well received, with over 300 participants. The Club will continue to promote and organize such events as part of its calendar of activities for the enjoyment of Members. Also, if you have not done so already, do check out the new pool and surroundings. It really does look superb, with gleaming tiles and crystal clear water!

The upgrading of the kitchen – the last of the five major projects approved by the house – is now underway. This kitchen, which serves the Kenanga Coffee House and the Lilasari Restaurant as well as our banqueting events, will be undergoing a thorough make-over to bring it up to date and in line with new health and safety standards. There will be minimum disruption to Members, as standby kitchen facilities will be put in place.

On a sad note, we wish to extend our condolences to the family of our Immediate Past Vice-President, Mr James Lee, who recently passed away after a long illness. James joined the Club in 1985 and served on the General Committee a number of times from 1994 onwards, taking diligent care of the portfolios of sports and recreation. He himself was both an active sportsperson and also in recreation. He was the Club's karaoke champion in 2014 and was also part of the Raintree Team that emerged as Champion at the 2013 Inter-club Karaoke Competition. His presence will be missed by many.

Finally, as you will see from a notice elsewhere in this magazine, this will be the last regular printed issue of the Samanea distributed to Members. We are discontinuing the full-fledged Samanea so that we can focus our efforts and resources on our brand new Club website. After much hard work, this went live on 27 February. If you have not yet checked it out, please do so now on [www.raintree.com.my](http://www.raintree.com.my). You will find a website that is much fresher, more user-friendly and full of useful content than the old one. It is also optimised for use on mobile devices as well as computers and laptops. Our aim is that the website should be the primary means of communication between the Club and its Members. It is there that you will find out first about forthcoming events and offers and other important developments, as well as reading reports with pictures of events that have taken place. So do check it out, and use it!

# The Raintree Club FAMILY FUNDAY

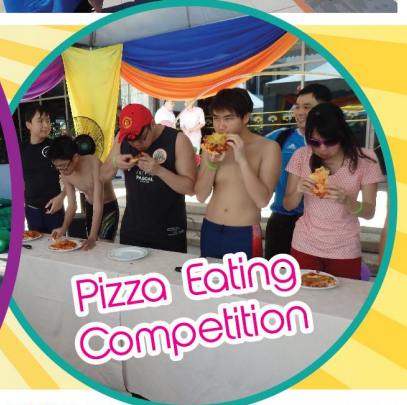
24TH JANUARY 2016 | 10AM-2PM

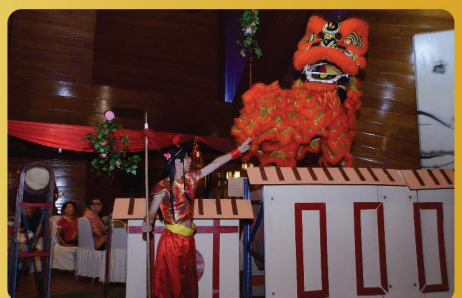
*Happy New Chinese Year*

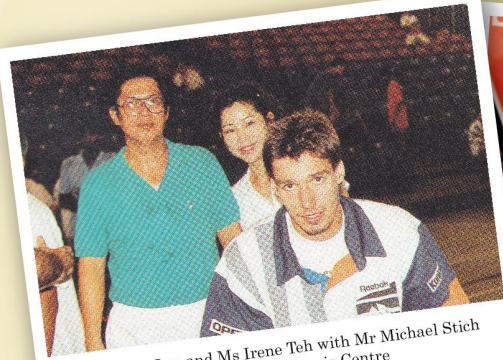

## MASTER SWIMMING IN SHAH ALAM DARUL EHSAN AQUATIC CENTRE 5TH DECEMBER 2015

The Master swimming event was organized by RSGC (Royal Selangor Golf Club). It was held in DEAC (Darul Ehsan Aquatic Centre) in Shah Alam.

The overall Champion this year was team name “Newave” (Made up of several teams from Kuala Lumpur). The team shall organize the Masters swimming event for the year of 2016.

There were only two representatives from Raintree; Mr William Ho and Ben Kam. Mr William Ho did well by obtaining two Silver and two Bronze medals.

## WHY SWIMMING IS GOOD FOR OLDER PEOPLE?

Swimming is a widely popular sport and recreational exercise. No wonder, for it can be a fun, effective and affordable workout. But there is more – the activity can improve one’s health, which makes it ideal for older people. It helps to keep chronic ailments such as diabetes, heart disease and hypertension at bay, said Me Carl Bradford, associate sport physiologist at Singapore Sports Institute.

Swimming is also a great option for people with joint pain, which tends to crop up as we age. There is less impact on the joints, compared with activities like running, and leads to less muscle soreness. Older people who find that their balance is getting poorer – which puts them at risk of falls when they do land-based sports- can turn to swimming, too. “Exercise in water provides a great alternative for those who may not have the balance or strength for other activities like walking, running or cycling,” Mr Bradford said. Also, while immersed, the water pressure causes fluid to move between body cells. “This will increase your blood volume, which can reduce cardiovascular stress by leading to a lower exercising heart rate,” he said.

However, one should realise that ageing affects the physical ability of the body. Therefore, older swimmers may wish to take note of the following points, as outlined by Mr Bradford.

### **DON'T FORGET TO STRETCH**

The joints’ range of motion, which is important when doing swim strokes, is often reduced as we get older. Stretching or mobility exercises are useful, particularly around the shoulder and ankle joints.

### **SEE A DOCTOR FIRST**

Swimming can raise one’s blood volume because of the effects of water pressure. However, while this can help to reduce one’s exercising heart rate, when combined with a horizontal body position and the breathe-hold pattern required while swimming, the higher blood volume can lead to higher blood pressure. This may be risky for people with pre-existing cardiovascular disease. It is best to discuss this with a doctor before starting a water-based exercise programme.

### **TAKE IT EASY**

Do not be overly ambitious from the get-go. Slowly increase your swim intensity and duration as you become fitter and more comfortable in the water.

### **FOR NEWBIES, CONSIDER LEARNING BACKSTROKE FIRST**

Going to the pool for the first time at middle age can be daunting. For some, learning backstroke first may help to provide a better awareness of the ideal body position to have, for instance.

### **BE PATIENT, LEARN FROM EXPERTS**

In swimming, a good “feel” for the water through the fingers and arms is very important in achieving the correct stroke patterns. However, as we age, some of our sensory perceptions are diminished. This can reduce the feel for the water, resulting in a more mechanical stroke and, overall, a slower learning curve. It is worthwhile to attend classed give nby an experienced instructor. Doing so may help to improve your technique and maximize your swimming enjoyment.
