PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Members,

As we move towards the end of the year, I am happy to reflect on the fact that it has been a really productive year indeed for your Club and GC.

Our top priority was to improve the Club's finances and stem losses. Efforts to achieve this began with the successful outsourcing of kitchen operations to a caterer, Chef Dino, late last year. This has helped to reduce staff costs significantly on the F&B side, as well as to improve the menu offering to Members.

A series of other important measures designed to generate more revenue and increase patronage of the Club were approved by Members at a landmark EGM in May:

- A long overdue increase in subscriptions of RM 30 per month from August 2019 (the last increased having been in March 1993!). This will have a major positive impact in putting the Club on a sound financial footing.
- Opening up term membership to Malaysians, which will allow us to expand our membership base and number of active Members without compromising the rights of existing Ordinary Members.
- Allowing qualifying older Members to transfer their membership to their children while themselves retaining the right to use the Club facilities as family members of the latter.
- Relocation of the Slot Machine Room to another location/building. This is subject to the approval of the Ministry of Finance, which the GC is currently working to obtain.

On Sports and Recreation, various events were held successfully at the Club during the year. These include the Go Green Flea Market Day, the Annual Karaoke Competition, the 20th Raintree International Jumbo Squash Doubles Competition, and the second edition of the new Raintree Tennis Malaysia tournament, which attracted the best players in Malaysia as well as a strong overseas contingent. The Lila Sari has just hosted a highly successful Deepavali Dinner. We are also proud to record that, at the recent Inter-Club Karaoke Competition held at the Royal Lake Club, our duet singers Irene Teh and Jenny Lee emerged as champions. Good job ladies!

Things are happening too at the Teratai Bar. In addition to a new three-piece band every Friday (selected by Members from three bands on an audition night), every Wednesday also features live music from a singer – and it's Ladies Night too!

Many further F&B promotions, not to mention an exciting New Year's Eve Party, are being lined up for the end of the year. Do come along and take part! We look forward to your support and participation.

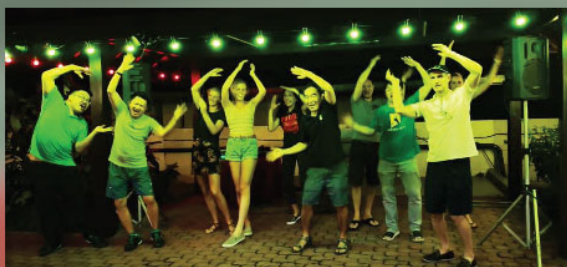
The league season commenced in March with six clubs from the KL area participating – RSGC, Royal Lake Club, KDE, Royal Selangor Club and newcomers Tropicana. Over the following five months Raintree played a total of ten (10) league matches home and away. For each match the Raintree team was made up of twelve players : three mens doubles pairs, two mixed doubles pairs and one ladies doubles pair.

Following an excellent run of results Raintree Tennis Club topped the league table by one point from RSGC. The top two teams in the league qualified for the final with Raintree against RSGC a repeat of the 2018 final. Once again Raintree emerged from the final victorious.

The annual Tunku Naqiyuddin Squash Jumbo Doubles has been one of the most high-profile events at the Raintree Club over the past 20 years. Celebrated this year in conjunction with World Squash Day, the Raintree hosted this 3-day event from 11-13 October.

Organised by our committed and dedicated Squash Committee, this year's Squash Jumbo Doubles for the Tunku Naqiyuddin Cup received participation not only from local and overseas clubs, but also from some national squash teams from South East Asia. In all, over 50 doubles teams took part, including some very strong players. Know Your Badminton Coach – P. Kantharoopan

Do you know our club's badminton coach comes with a string of achievements?

Coach Kantha started playing badminton from a young age of eight, and was one of the top junior shuttlers in his time. He bagged a double by winning the boys' Under-15 singles and doubles at the MSSM meet in 1987. In 1988, he won a silver medal in the boys' Under-18 singles at the national junior championships. The young Kantha was part of the Kuala Lumpur victorious team winning the back-to-back team event at the biennial Malaysia Games in 1988 and 1990.

Coach Kantha was a national player under the Badminton Association of Malaysia (BAM) from 1989 to 1997. During that period, he had many achievements including semi-finalist in the US Open and Brunei Open in 1995, quarter-finalist in the Canadian Open and Malaysian Open (1996), and reaching the 3rd round of the All England Championships. He also qualified and played in the World Championships. Coach Kantha registered a career high ranking of No. 32 in the world in 1994. He was one of the Thomas Cup trainees for men singles, but was just squeezed out of the final line-up by more notable singles players such as Rashid Sidek, Ong Ewe Hock and Foo Kok Keong.

Besides his coaching duties at the Raintree, Coach Kantha is also a regular sparring partner for the Kuala Lumpur Badminton Association's (KLBA) players. His other duty is to scout for young talent for the KLBA. So if you register your young ones for badminton coaching sessions at Raintree, who knows, one day they could become our Raintree Club Olympic Gold medalists in badminton!
